Lucky me, I found an Omnibus of the first three books and love book one and two and will be starting the third soon. We have here a great cast of players on a very large stage, the good guys and girls are sort of good and the bad guys and girls are really wicked and awful people. Jonathan Moeller has done it again. At first I thought it was going to be a paranormal series, I'm not into that type of storyline, I was really surprised at his concept of Ghost Assassins and how they help the kingdom. This is a great adventure story that keeps you reading and wanting more.

Story line is different and interesting. I'm on the 5th book right now, so I guess you could say I'm hooked into it! It's pretty good overall. A small problem with the spelling of certain words repeated throughout, but otherwise acceptable.

Started with the demonsouled series and loved it so much I moved on to frostborn..now ...the ghosts series. All I can say thank you for rich characters twisting plots...and lack of sleep. I can't put them down!

I am seriously addicted to this series. However, the poor editing is rather annoying. It is as if spell check was used, and no one read it over to be sure the correct words were used. It is easy to assume the intended language, but it is simply annoying.

You don't know what you are missing!! She is a kick ass! He is a great author. I have enjoys all of his books so far. He does take you on a good adventure in every book. You are never sure which character to get close to. the series The Ghost has action, adventure, intrigue, friendship, and all around good book to enjoy. Is it part love story but not the mushy kind of love. He does explain the past book in each new one. So if you get started on book 4 (for example), he does go back to the past stories so you can follow along and not have to stop and go back to read books 1-3 just to understand book 4. THIS A A GREAT SERIES. Worth more than what I paid for it.

I liked the first three and ordered the fourth one. I found it to be just a repeat of the plots from 1-3

and was bored early. Needed something else to happen. I have not finished number 4 yet and may go back later to see if some character development happens later in the book.

I have to say up front, that I did enjoy the book. That said, there were A LOT of grammar errors , wrong words , words in the wrong place , etc .The characters could have been so much more enjoyable(or hated), If only the author had taken the time to develop them more , told us more about them. It is a good theme, but I don't think I will buy the rest of the books in this series. I wish these authors would use proofreaders before publishing.
