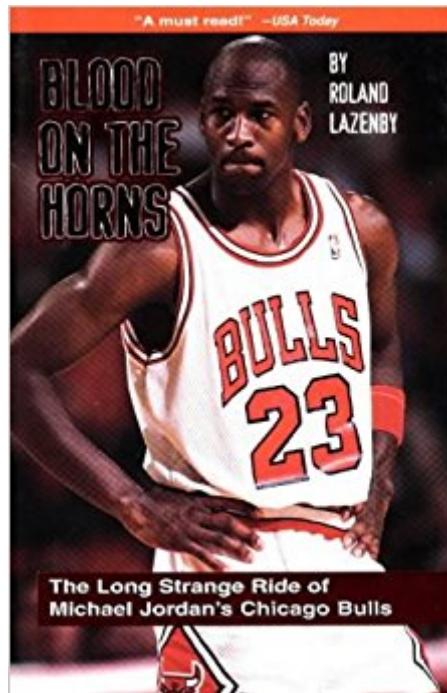

It provides a more real version of the inner workings of the Bulls situation when they won the titles. If you're caught up with Jordan being perfect, well, you may not want to read this book. Jordan is no question a superb basketball player; one of the best. But basically he loves himself a bit too much, was a total jerk, had little respect for his bosses, was very demeaning to Krause and his fellow teammates, etc. Jordan did a great job in dealing with the media to get them on his side and hence, he was successful in making himself extremely influential to the public and using that to destroy those such as Krause who he didn't like.
