

Alaska: A Climbing Guide is very well done with routes and mountains that most climbers have not heard of. There is enough information in this guide to get you there and to get your interest piqued, but not so much that it will take the adventure out of an Alaska expedition. Routes like the West Buttress on Denali are not covered (there is a book by Coombs on just that route alone), but all major ranges in Alaska have at least one peak listed. Many routes will need rock, ice, and snow skills plus the approach. Often the approach will be more difficult and time consuming than the climb itself. Truly a great read to start you dreaming and planning a climb on a route less traveled. I wish it was longer and had more photos (all black and white). Enjoy the book!
