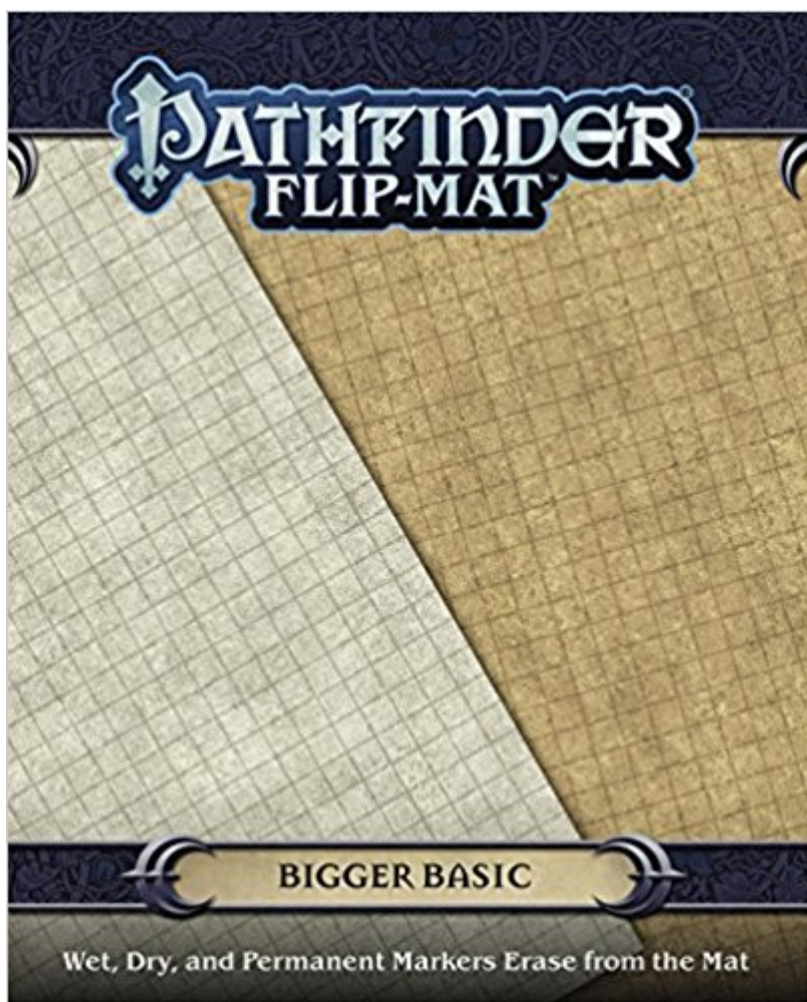

## Customer Reviews

I have been using dry erase markers on it, and it works fine. I do, however, always erase after a session. I don't want to take a chance and have it not come off, after all. But it is folded, so it doesn't lay completely flat. That's a problem. A big problem. But I don't know if there's a solution. Even a rolled one wouldn't work that well because it wouldn't be flat, either. So the mat isn't perfect, but it's about as good as it gets.

A perfect alternative to my usual roll up mats. This this is large and fits in any one of my binders or

bags. I haven't used a permanent marker on them but I'm sure if you follow the instructions on the packaging it would work fine. A great accessory for any DM.

I ended up buying another game mat after this one because I am not pleased with how this one arcs up after being folded and I can imagine in a short time this will end up wearing out on the folds. This is not my first choice but I keep it around for specific situations.

We bought this for my son. The mat is of a really good quality and works well for our son as Dungeon master. He is really happy that he can write on it with Sharpie and it cleans right off when they are done.

I play D & D, and I got this as a present for my DM, so he doesn't have to use the cheap, little, grimy whiteboard he was using anymore. As of now we don't use miniatures, we use little tokens, and whiteboard markers; which work, [and most importantly] wipe off with ease (just be careful, and try not marking on the fold edges; they can be a bit hard to get the marker off of them... be warned). Though it was a little difficult to get it to lay perfectly flat when we used it, keep in mind; it was the first time we used it, and all the folds are still crisp, and new. The mat just needs to be broken in, and used, so I didn't really consider it a problem (oh no, it's too new). Also it folds down into a nice small size for storing, or packing it, so I think it's fantastic, I liked using it a lot! Far more immersive than a whiteboard...

I wish it wasn't folded. It creates creases that really hinder it's full potential. It would have been nicer to simply get a roll out mat.

Ok. It's big enough to have a lot of fun, but the folding gets in the way, that's because the folding lines have to be weighted down with books and things like that. It would be better if it was cutted cardboard and you can put the pieces together.

I have no idea why I didn't try these sooner. Once I purchased one of them, I bought three more. I now have four of them and use them to make a massive board for my tabletop games.
